

Short CV of Eric Goles

Born in Antofagasta, 21 august 1951, Chile.

Goles is professor at the Adolfo Ibanez University, Santiago, Chile. He was previously professor at the Ingeneering School, University of Chile (1977-2006); Head of the Center for Mathematical Modeling (Universidad de Chile, 1997-2000); President of the National (Chilean) Council for Sciences, CONICYT (2000-2006); Head of the Valparaiso Institute for Complex Systems (ISCV; Valparaiso, Chile, 2002- 2007); Member of the Chilean Academy of Science (1990-); Member of the Croatian Academy of Science (2006-). He has several awards as the the chilean nacional award of science (1993); condecorations (France, Brasil, Spain). He has made contributions to Theoretical Computer Sciences (more than 130 articles and several books) and he is the creator of the chilean group in this discipline. Further, He has been the conductor of a prime-time show (about 40 programs) on the Chilean television (TVN) about scientific and technological topics (1996 – 2008) The program has been awarded with IAMS to the best scientific documentary (Tele-Science, Montreal) and the UNESCO-CNRS Prize Jules Verne.
